Galatian 5:22-23 (NET)

The Kingdom of God word (Galatians 5:14)

- Eros based on <u>beauty</u>.
- Storge based on bloodline.
- Philia based on likes.
- Agape based on <u>nothing</u>.

Agape does not require value – it imparts value.

Importance of Love in the Kingdom of God

Practical Examples of Love Today (1 John 3:16; 1 John 4:10-11)

- 1. No one can do our <u>growing</u> for us, but we do grow better <u>together</u>.
- 2. God's love through us <u>notices</u> and <u>values</u> those around us.
- 3. Christ-like leaders care more about their <u>people</u> than their <u>positions</u>.

- 4. Even though we may disagree, we keep trying to find common ground.
- 5. We always elevate <u>service to others</u> over <u>personal</u> entitlement.

## How Do We Get Love Inside Us

- 1. Understand the <u>depth</u> of <u>God's love</u> for you. (Ephesians 3:17-19; Luke 7:36-47)
- Receive God's love. (1 John 4:19; Romans 5:8)
  Capacity to love comes from receiving love.
- 3. Choose to love. (Colossians 3:14)

Choices lead. Feelings follow. (Matthew 6:21)

Whatever I love becomes an obsession.

Whatever I become obsessed with I <u>imitate</u>.

Whatever I imitate I become.

What I love <u>changes me</u> into the image of what I love.
